

## **The Lantana Alcohol Guidelines**

We are required by Massachusetts State Law to Strictly uphold all laws and regulations regarding the serving of alcohol. It is our intention to provide all guests with responsible service of alcoholic beverages.

1. The Lantana reserves the right to limit, suspend or terminate alcohol service without notice, at any time, with no refund of money during any part of the function where, in our opinion, our liquor license or the comfort & safety of guests may be in jeopardy either at the event or after the event, whether on the premises or not, even if an open bar has been paid for. This is one of the most standard alcohol rules in the hospitality industry with any venue that holds a liquor license.
2. We do not have a "last call" for any bar whether cash or open, whether unlimited or not.
3. Massachusetts's law prohibits the service of more than two alcoholic beverages to one person at any time. Someone may come to the bar and help them from their table if necessary.
4. The bartender must ask for identification for guests that look under the age of 35 years of age per Massachusetts's liquor laws. If the person cannot provide identification, they will not be served. If our staff sees underage guests consuming or in the possession of alcohol, the bar can be closed down.
5. Special requests can be accommodated most of the time but you will need to speak with your Sales & Catering manager. This should be done in a timely fashion at least 2 weeks prior to the function. This may incur a surcharge.
6. The Lantana policy prohibits the serving of shots or three liquor drinks!
7. It is against the law to have alcohol taken off our premises. This includes wine bottles that have been purchased at an event.
8. The Lantana only accepts cash at the bars. There is an ATM machine available in the building.
9. If our staff sees a guest with alcoholic beverages brought into the building or onto the premises, The Lantana reserves the right to take it from this person and dispose of it. It is also against the law to bring alcoholic beverages out to our fountain area. If the guest is uncooperative they will be asked to leave the premises.
10. The service of alcohol before 12 noon on a Sunday is prohibited.
11. If you are having your ceremony here, the bar will not open until the ceremony is over. Please inform your bridal party of this. And again no one is allowed to bring alcohol onto the premises or in the building.
12. The bar will close 15 minutes before the end of the function and may be closed earlier if necessary.
13. The Lantana will not keep the bar open for more than 5 hours, even if you have an extra hour planned for your function.
